## WHAT IS THE TEEN ARTS FESTIVAL?

The Atlantic County Teen Arts Festival, a multidisciplinary program in the fine and performing arts, has served students and teachers in both public and private schools since 1969. It encompasses activities in dance, theatre, vocal music, instrumental music, film, the visual arts, photography, and creative writing. Teens participate through a one day event run by the County Office of Cultural & Heritage Affairs and held annually in May on the campus of Richard Stockton College of New Jersey. There they display their talent, meet with professionals in the field for critique, and attend hands-on workshops or master classes. This Visual Art Exhibit was established to provide more showcase opportunities for teens. Work included was selected by professional artists at the Festival.
