Methodology


- Parental consent forms were sent home with all 9th and 11th grade students from 12 Atlantic County high schools. Surveys were given to those students who returned the signed consent forms.
- Data collection took place between January and February 2016.
- A total of 1,755 surveys were completed during class time, collected, and returned to Holleran.
- 950 of the 1,755 surveys were analyzed yielding an overall error rate of +/-3% at the 95% confidence level.


Percent of students who rated their health as "fair" or "poor"




Percent of students who never or rarely wore a helmet while riding a bicycle during the past 12 months






How often do you wear a seat belt when riding in a car driven by someone else?


Percent of students who never or rarely wore a seat belt when riding in a car driven by someone else during the past year






Percent of students who rode with a driver who had been drinking alcohol in the past 30 days








During the past 30 days, how many times did you drive a car or other vehicle when you had been drinking alcohol?


Percent of students who drove after drinking alcohol in the past 30 days


During the past 30 days, how many times did you text or e-mail while driving a car or other vehicle?


Percent of students who carried a weapon on school property in the past 30 days










During the past 30 days, on how many days did you not go to school because you felt you would be unsafe at school or on your way to or from school?






Percent of students who did not go to school because they felt they would be unsafe at school or on their way to or from school during the past 30 days






Percent of students who were threatened or injured with a weapon on school property in the past 12 months






Percent of students who were in injured in a physical fight and had to be treated by a doctor or nurse in the past 12 months








Percent of students who were intentionally physically hurt by someone they were dating or going out with in the past 12 months




During the past 12 months, how many times did someone you were dating or going out with force you to do sexual things you did not want to do?




Percent of students who were forced to sexual things they did not want to do by someone they were dating or going out with in the past 12 months




During the past 12 months, did you ever feel so sad or hopeless almost every day for two weeks or more in a row that you stopped doing some usual activities?



Percent of students who have felt sad or hopeless almost every day for two or more weeks in a row that you stopped doing some usual activities in the past 12 months




Percent of students whose suicide attempt resulted in an injury, poisoning, or overdose that had to be treated by a doctor or nurse in the past 12 months






Percent of students who smoked at least 1 cigarette in the past 30 days






Do you think that using an electronic vapor product is less harmful to your health than smoking cigarettes?






Percent of students who have had at least one drink of alcohol in their life










Percent of students who were 12 years old or younger when they had their first drink of alcohol






During the past 30 days, what is the largest number of alcoholic drinks you had in a row, that is, within a couple hours?






During the past 30 days, how many times did you use marijuana on school property?




Percent of students who have used marijuana at least once on school property in the past 30 days




Percent of students who have had 1 or more sexual partners in the past 3 months






The last time you had sexual intercourse, did you or your partner use a condom?




Percent of students who used a condom when they had sexual intercourse the last time




Percent of students who used a condom when they had sexual intercourse the last time




The last time you had sexual intercourse, what method or methods did you or your partner use to prevent pregnancy?




Percent of students who used no protection when they had sexual intercourse the last time


Percent of students who describe their weight as "Slightly overweight" or "Very overweight"


Percent of students who exercised to lose weight or to keep from gaining weight during the past 30 days








Percent of students who ate less food, fewer calories, or foods low in fat to lose weight or to keep from gaining weight in the past 30 days








Percent of students who vomited or took laxatives to lose weight or to keep from gaining weight in the past 30 days

Percent of students who ate fruit at least once in the past 7 days








Percent of students who ate green salad at least once in the past 7 days




Percent of students who ate green salad at least once in the past 7 days




During the past 7 days, how many times did you eat potatoes?






Percent of students who ate potatoes at least once in the past 7 days






During the past 7 days, how many times did you eat carrots?






Percent of students who ate carrots at least once in the past 7 days







Percent of students who ate other vegetables at least once in the past 7 days







Percent of students who drank soda at least once in the past 7 days






During the past 7 days, how many times did you drink an energy drink (such as Monster, Rock Star, AMP, or Red Bull)?




Percent of students who drank an energy drink at least once in the past 7 days




During the past 7 days, how many times did you drink a can, bottle, or glass of a sports drink such as Gatorade or PowerAde?




Percent of students who drank a sports drink at least once in the past 7 days




During the past 7 days, how many times did you drink a bottle or glass of plain water?




Percent of students who drank water at least once in the past 7 days




During the past 7 days, how many glass(es) of milk did you drink?






Percent of students who drank milk at least once in the past 7 days










Percent of students who were physically active for at least 30 minutes on at least one day during the past 7 days




During the past 7 days, on how many days were you physically active for a total of at least 60 minutes per day?




Percent of students who were physically active for a total of at least 60 minutes on at least one day during the past 7 days 9th grade students




Percent of students who were physically active for a total of at least 60 minutes on at least one day during the past 7 days






During the past 7 days, on how many days did you do exercises to strengthen or tone your muscles such as push-ups, sit-ups, or weight lifting?




Percent of students who did exercises to strengthen or tone their muscles on at least one day during the past 7 days






Percent of students who watch 3 or more hours of TV on an average school day






Percent of students who play video or computer games or use a computer for something that is not school work for 3 hours or more on an average school day

Percent of students who go to physical education classes at least once during an average week in school






Percent of students who have ever been tested for HIV




During the past 12 months, how many times have you had a sunburn?








Percent of students who have seen a doctor or primary care provider in the last 12 months






Percent of students who have been to the dentist in the last 12 months




On an average school night, how many hours of sleep do you get?






Percent of students who get at least 8 hours of sleep on an average school night






Percent of students who have ever had a doctor or nurse tell them that they have asthma






Percent of students who describe their grades in the past 12 months as mostly A's and B's





Percent of students who speak English "Very well" or "Well"




Percent of students who rarely or never feel hopeful about the future








Percent of students who participated in an extracurricular school activity in the past year






Percent of students who have had a part-time job in the past year









Percent of students who have done volunteer work in the county in the past year
