Orientation Program

In order to obtain a range ID, you must attend an orientation program, that reviews range rules and regulations and goes over policies and procedures.

Dates: Contact range office for upcoming dates.

Time: 1-2 hours.

Cost: No fee.

Course: This program is designed to provide the participant with all the information that he/she will need to have an enjoyable, **safe** visit at the Atlantic County Public Range Facility. The program reviews all of the range rules and regulations for the pistol, rifle, shotgun and archery facilities at the range. **Safety** is reinforced throughout the program. Participants will be provided with a copy of the range manual and other informational literature as well as be given the opportunity to have answered any questions regarding the facility and it's use. A tour of the range will also be given.

This program is required for everyone wishing to get a range identification card.

What you need to bring:

- Pen and notebook.
- All other material will be provided.
- Applications will be available to be completed during this program.
- **Two forms of ID with name and home address on them.**
- **Any Proof of safety training. ex: (NJ Hunter Educational Courses)**
